Instructions

- 1. THE PLAYER STARTS TO FLIP ONE CARD AT A TIME AND READS THE GURUDWARA EVENT ON IT.
- 2. IF THE PLAYER BELIEVES THEY HAVE FOUND THE CORRECT PLACE FOR THE CARD, THEY CAN PLACE IT IN THE GRID.
- **3. THE PLAYER CONTINUES THIS PROCESS UNTIL** THEY HAVE **ARRANGED THE CARDS** IN THE CORRECT CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER.
- 4. WHEN THE PLAYER IS CONFIDENT IN THEIR ARRANGEMENT, THEY CAN REVEAL THE COMPLETE IMAGE OF THE BEAUTIFUL GURUDWARA BY CHECKING THE BACK.

Hints!

- 1. 1469 marks the birth of the founder of Sikhism, whose teachings emphasize unity, equality, and devotion.
- 2. In 1577, Guru Ram Das Ji established a city and initiated a sacred pool symbolizing purity. It's a city known for its spiritual significance.
- 3. In 1604, Guru Arjan Dev Ji completed the compilation of sacred scripture, emphasizing the importance of Sikh teachings.
- 4. In 1699, this significant event involved Guru Gobind Singh Ji initiating a community known for its values of equality and discipline.
- 5. In 1708, the scripture became the guiding light after the passing of which Guru?
- 6. In 1830, a tragic event in Sikh history during this year inspired later movements for religious rights. It involved a significant place of pilgrimage.
- 7. In 1921, Sikhs demonstrated their commitment to religious rights during this movement, and it gained momentum in the early 20th century.
- 8. In 1984, a controversial military action took place during this year at the Golden Temple, a sacred site for Sikhs, leading to significant repercussions.
- 9. In 1999, an operation aimed to regain control of a sacred Sikh institution, showcasing the resilience and determination of the Sikh community.
- 10. In 2019, a corridor was inaugurated, facilitating pilgrimages between Indian and Pakistani Sikh shrines, and fostering connections.
